[or if any member of fund A who is an elective officer of a participating municipality is so separated after attaining the age of sixty years and after completing at least twenty years of continuous service but before reaching the voluntary retirement age, ] or if any member of fund B is so separated after completing at least ten years of continuous service but before reaching the voluntary retirement age, [or if any member of fund A is separated from the service of the municipality by which he is employed to accept an appointment to any salaried position with the state of Connecticut after completing at least twenty-five years of continuous service and before reaching the voluntary retirement age, | he shall be entitled to a retirement allowance upon reaching the voluntary retirement age; provided, at the option of the member, the retirement allowance may commence on the date of such separation and be payable in such an amount as
