AN ACT CONCERNING FISCAL INDEPENDENCE FOR LOCAL BOARDS OF EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Notwithstanding any statute, local ordinance or charter provision to the contrary, any town, city or borough may, in accordance with and subject to the requirements of chapter 99 of the general statutes, grant fiscal independence to its board of education.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: To enable municipalities to grant local boards of education fiscal independence.
