**AN ACT CONCERNING** PAYMENT TO WIDOW OF CURTIS J. HOOPER  
IN LIEU OF GROUP LIFE INSURANCE BENEFIT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. The Comptroller shall draw his order on the Treasurer, in favor of Marion Hooper, widow of the late Curtis J. Hooper, a Deputy Commissioner in the Department of Transportation, in the amount equal to that which he would have been entitled to under the State's group life insurance plan had he completed his six months of reemployment.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: Curtis J. Hooper, a former employee of the State for eighteen (18) years, was recalled to service as Deputy Commissioner, Bureau of Planning and Research of the Department of Transportation. Mr. Hooper passed away after serving five (5) months and Twenty-three (23) days in his new capacity. The Statutes require six (6) months of employment to be eligible for group insurance coverage. In respect for his previous State employment and his recent service to the State, this death benefit to his widow is justified.
