**AN ACT CONCERNING** ESTABLISHMENT OF A CONNECTICUT  
COORDINATE SYSTEM

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Subsection (g) of Section 13a-255 is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof: Said commissioner or his agent or agents may enter upon private property for the purpose of surveying, establishing or maintaining the survey. He shall use care so that no unnecessary damage shall result to any private property and the state shall ((be liable)) pay damages to the owner of such property from appropriations made to the department of transportation for any damage ((so caused)) or injury he causes such owner by such entrance and use.

Section 2. This Act shall take effect from passage.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: To enable the Commissioner of Transportation to pay an owner directly for any damage or injury to his property as a result of surveying to establish a Connecticut coordinate system.
