AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROTECTION OF AUTOMOBILE OWNERS AGAINST
DEFECTIVE WORKMANSHIP.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Assembly convened:

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: To require that all automobile mechanics
and service dealers be licensed to assure that all automobile
repair work is performed by qualified personnel, examined and
licensed by the state, who will guarantee their workmanship by
making corrections without charge of all poor or defective
repairs and to establish maximum service charges for work to
prevent gouging of the public.
