AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE HARTFORD COUNTY BAR
LIBRARY.

CONNECTICUT

LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE
SECTION

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Assembly convened:

Section 11-18a of the 1969 supplement to the general
statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
thereof: The state treasurer shall pay annually to the law
libraries specified in this section the amounts therein shown or
any greater amounts which may from time to time be appropriated.
Such payments shall be made as follows: New Haven Bar Library,
thirty-three thousand eighteen dollars; Waterbury Bar Library,
twenty-two thousand one hundred dollars; Meriden Bar Library,
seven thousand six hundred dollars; Norwich Law Library, six
thousand one hundred dollars; New London Law Library, six
thousand one hundred dollars; Bridgeport Law Library, thirty-five
thousand one hundred dollars; Danbury Law Library, three thousand
six hundred dollars; Stamford Law Library, twelve thousand one
hundred dollars; Middlesex County Law Library, four thousand one
hundred twenty dollars; Hartford County Law Library, [thirty-six]
FORTY-EIGHT thousand [one hundred] dollars; Naugatuck Valley Bar
Library, ten thousand dollars; New Britain Law Library, ten
thousand one hundred dollars; Winchester Law Library, one
thousand three hundred dollars; New Milford Law Library, one
thousand three hundred dollars; Torrington Law Library, one
thousand three hundred dollars; Litchfield Law Library, two
thousand eight hundred dollars; Putnam Law Library, one thousand

nine hundred twenty dollars; Willimantic Law Library, one 43
thousand nine hundred twenty dollars; and Tolland Law Library, 44
three thousand six hundred dollars. 45
