**Raised SB 127 An Act Concerning The Appointment of Sub-registrars For The
Issuance of Removal, Transit, Burial and Cremation Permits
February 24, 2016**

Good morning Co-Chairs Senator Gerratana and Representative Ritter, Vice-Chairs Senator Crisco and Representative Riley and Ranking Members Senator Markley and Representative Srinivasan and members of the Public Health Committee.

Thank you for the opportunity to testify before you today on SB 127 An Act Concerning The Appointment of Sub-registrars For The Issuance of Removal, Transit, Burial and Cremation Permits.

I would like to request that the Public Health Committee consider amending subsection (b) of Section 7-65 of the general statutes to require the appointment of sub-registrars who issue removal, transit, burial and cremation permits be approved by the chief elected official rather than the currently stated selectmen. The current language in Section 7-65 states approval of the Selectmen which applies only to our small towns and caused confusion by the corporation council of our larger cities as to who should be providing the appointment approvals as they are governed by Mayors. This simple fix would meet the clarification needed by both our cities and towns.

I appreciate having the opportunity to offer testimony and respectfully request that you give favorable consideration to this clarification.
